What does SSVF Provide?

1) Rapid Re-Housing for Homeless Veterans

- Housing location assistance to quickly move people out of shelter and into a home of their own – serving both Cuyahoga County & Lake County
- Security deposit & short-term rental assistance (if needed)
- Linkage to services, case management, including home visits
- Can assist with utilities, emergency supplies, moving, furniture, and other obstacles to housing (if necessary)

2) Eviction Prevention & Shelter Diversion for At-Risk Veterans

- Landlord mediation services, or housing relocation assistance (if necessary)
- Security deposit & short-term rental assistance (if needed)
- Linkage to services, case management, including home visits
- Also serving doubled-up/couch-surfing vets at the brink of shelter entry

Who does SSVF Serve?

- Veterans and their families (discharge status: any, but “dishonorable”)
- Veterans from \$0 income on up to 50% of AMI (approx. \$1945 per month)
- Veterans living in a shelter, transitional housing, or ‘on the streets’
- Veterans at-risk of becoming homeless due to a pending eviction, or the loss of safe place to sleep. Call (216) 674-6700 [Press 1] to ask questions!
